PREVENTIVE MEASURES COVID - 19

- Due to the current situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, it is still necessary to carry out a series of preventative measures in order to reduce the transmission of the virus by contact and more specifically in areas where there is likely to be overcrowding.
- All those involved in the event, whether they are visitors, staff, collaborators, members or participants will be expected to adhere to these measures.

PRE-EVENT REQUIREMENTS

This individual process is essential in order to participate in the event and to access to the RCNP facilities.



DURING THE EVENT

ACCESS CONTROL

- The accreditation bracelet will be delivered at the Race Office only after having filled in the online form: https://www.orcscorer.com/web_covid/index.php?orden=210910110628
- The Event accreditation must be worn/shown at the different entrances to the RCNP.
- All over the club there will be signs displaying the maximum capacity allowed and the club staff will make sure that those capacities are respected.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The **face mask** should be worn according to the local requirements at the time of the event. If this were today, masks are mandatory always inside and outside when not being able to keep a safe distance (i.e. Sailing Lounge). Therefore, the use of a mask is **COMPULSORY** inside the club.
- **Hand sanitizer** dispensers will be available at the entrance of all public rooms and/or zones
- Participants and attendees will be required to clean and disinfect their hands regularly and to sanitize frequently touched surfaces and objects.
- A **social distance** of at least 1,5m should be maintained and respected at all times.
- Access to indoor spaces will be limited to ensure proper social distancing.
- The club staff will be responsible for monitoring and ensuring measures and protocols (social distancing, the correct use of face mask, use of hydroalcoholic gel...etc)
- **Special cleaning** is implemented all over the club.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth, as your hands facilitate its transmission.
- Avoid physical contact (shaking hands, hugs or kisses).
- Avoid sharing objects for personal use such as mobile phones and other devices or office supplies / objects for individual use (pencils, pens, headphones ...)
- Everyone involved with the event is asked to respect the bubble and limit any contact outside of the event area or with the public.
- It is strongly recommended to do online operations, when possible, in order to avoid physical contact.

PROTOCOL in case of a positive result

- The 52 SUPER SERIES will always refer to the local authorities and the local measures and protocols at the time that the circumstance occurs.

MEDICAL SERVICE:

- During the event, there will be a medical service available at the RCNP **Monday 1st to Saturday 6th**. Please note that the event medical service do not include COVID-19 tests.
- COVID-19 Medical test can be arranged at Hospital Quirónsalud Palmaplanas (address: Camí dels Reis, 308, 07010 Palma de Mallorca. + 34 971 91 80 00) with results in 6h aprox. for those team members who need a negative result before their departure.
